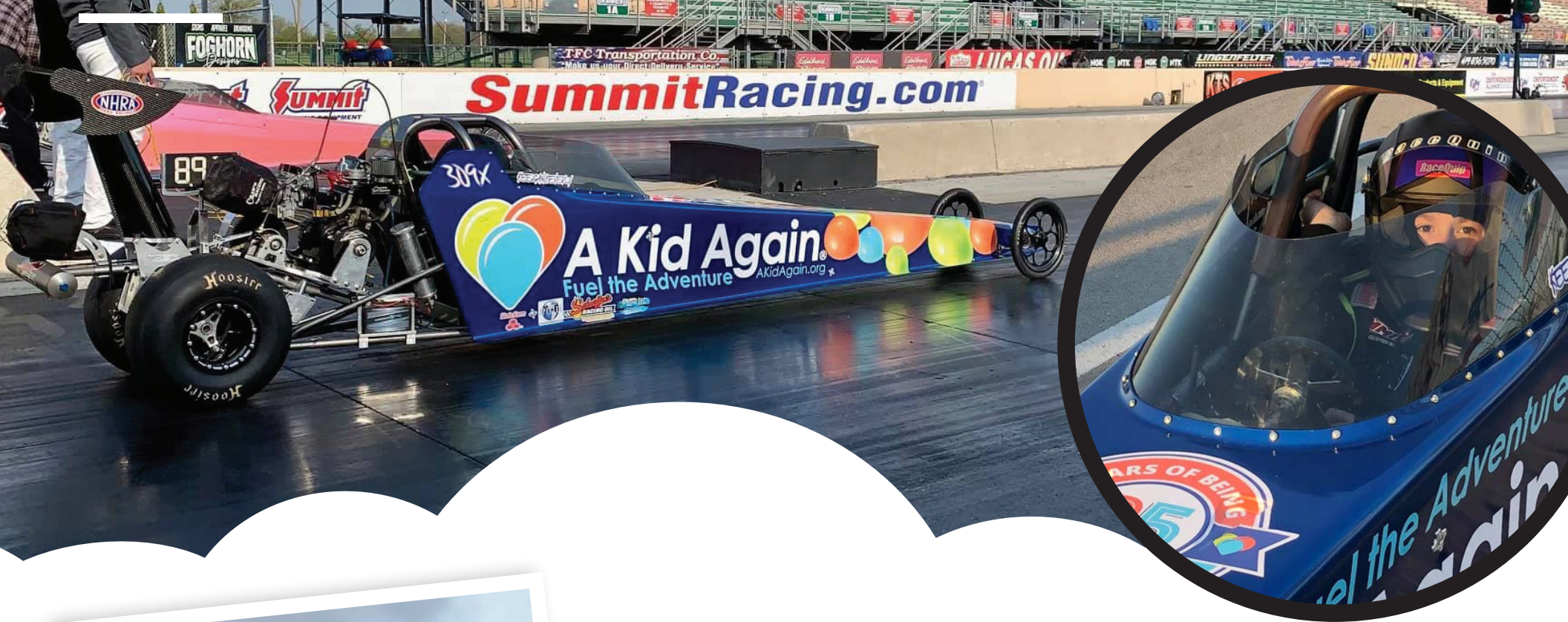
Grants give Indiana families

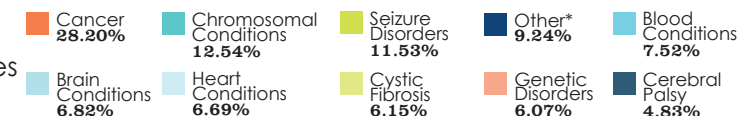
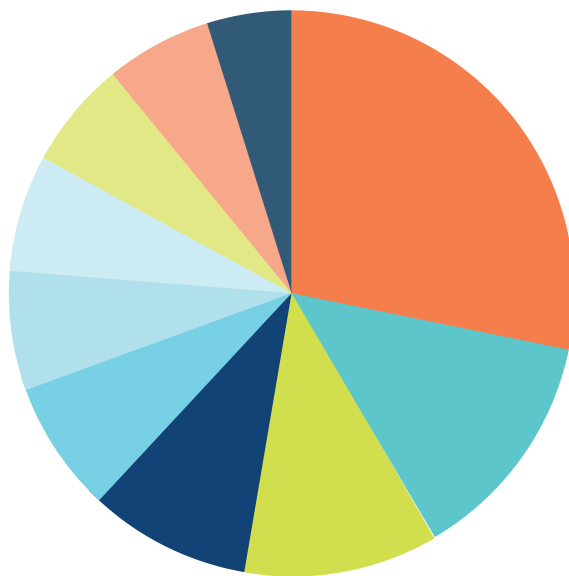
The Children We Serve

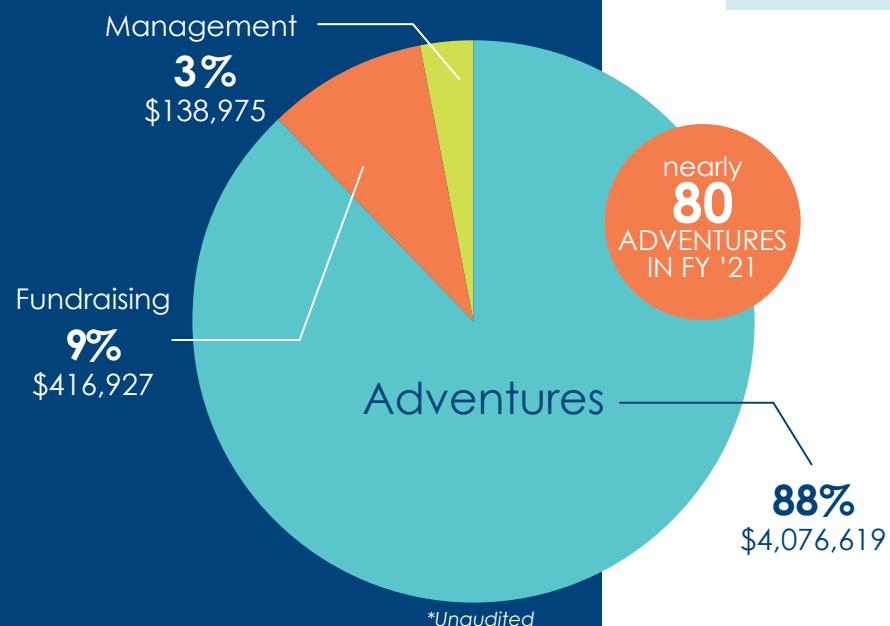
